1.0 Purpose of Policy:

The purpose of this policy is to provide the Ohio local law enforcement community with guidelines for access to the ***Ohio Local Law Enforcement Information-Sharing Network***.

2.0 Scope of Policy:

The scope of this policy includes all sworn law enforcement officers and non-sworn civilian law enforcement employees who are granted access to the Ohio Local Law Enforcement Information-Sharing Network by their agency Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or his/her designee.

3.0 Background:

The Ohio Local Law Enforcement Information-Sharing Network (hereafter referred to as "Network") is a system established by the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, on behalf of local law enforcement in Ohio, to facilitate information sharing among law enforcement agencies. The purpose of the Network is to provide access to the information necessary to prevent and respond to acts of terrorism and crime. Improper use of the Network may result in violation of public records laws, invasion of privacy, lost productivity, or may jeopardize the security of the Network.
